2012 Maintenance:

Contract labor- Crepe myrtle trees trimmed, mulch applied, lawn mowed and small trees removed

Neighbors- Additional trees and branches removed, leaves removed, biannual cleanup

2012 Improvement Objectives:

Obscure view of chain-link fence with low maintenance, deer resistant evergreen bushes and trees that provide added benefit of multi-seasonal color. Plant spring blooming bulbs.

2012 Improvements Accomplished:

- Applied for and obtained \$500 grant from Williamsburg Beautification Committee.
- Obtained horticultural advice regarding plant selection
- Prepared area for installation of evergreens bushes (neighbors)
- Planted 5 Rhododendrons, 3 fall blooming camellias, 1 confederate jasmine vine and, 1 cleyera bush.
- Purchased narcissus bulbs.

2013 Improvement Objectives:

- Complete installation of evergreens to obscure fence
- Plant bulbs (1/18/13-completed by neighbors)
- Potentially remove dying crepe myrtle

Major changes to Landscape budget:

- Contract leaf removal
- Increased funding for mulch
- Allocated funds for improvement initiatives
